Introduction

There may be instances whereby CIOL Qualifications (CIOLQ) allows candidates to demonstrate, through their previous certificated achievement that they have already met the requirement of a unit and do not need to be assessed against those units agreed.

This policy sets out the process and guidance for CIOLQ candidates and centres. It seeks to support candidates to avoid duplication of learning where this may be valid and appropriate for CIOL Qualifications.

Scope

This policy is aimed at candidates, recognised centres, internal CIOLQ staff and third parties. It applies to our recognised qualifications. More detailed information can be found in the relevant qualification specification.

Rationale for Recognition of Prior Learning

In line with the regulatory arrangements Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is defined as:

- Identification by an awarding organisation of any learning undertaken, and/or attainment, by a learner prior to taking a qualification which the awarding organisation makes available.
- It is a method of assessment (leading to the award of credit) that considers whether a learner can demonstrate that they can meet the assessment requirements for a unit through knowledge, understanding or skills they already possess and do not need to develop through a course of learning.

Where RPL is permitted for one of our qualifications, RPL must be an integrated part of centres' quality assurance process and must follow the criteria listed below:

- Where a claim for RPL is permitted it must represent at least one complete unit within a qualification. It is not possible to award credit for partial completion of a unit.
- It is the individual candidates' choice and responsibility to decide whether or not they wish to claim RPL if this is permitted.

RPL and Exemptions

This would be an exemption. Any opportunities for exemptions will be outlined within the relevant qualification specification.

Equivalent Units

In the event that any of our qualifications permit RPL, the use of an equivalent unit will not attract additional credit, as the skills knowledge and / or competences described in the unit will have already been recognised in the credit system.

Policy updating and reviewing

All policies relating to CIOLQ will be updated on an 18-month cycle or sooner as required.
